## ATHLETIC SCHEDULES

**FOOTBALL** – Keenan Kuntz and Max Workman hauled in touchdown passes from Colby Danielson who also scored on the ground. Colby Price and Johnny Talarico added rushing touchdowns for Mead and the Panthers defeated the Ferris Saxons 35-0 Friday night. The Boys are 4-1 in League play (3<sup>rd</sup> place overall, 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 3A) and return to Union Friday night against Lewis & Clark.

**SLOW PITCH SOFTBALL** – The Panthers lost a 1<sup>st</sup> place showdown against University on Monday 9-8, but bounced back with two big wins, 22-0 over North Central and 15-1 at Cheney. In Friday's win over the Blackhawks, Campbell Brose went 4 for 5 and drove in 2 runs. The Girls are 9-1 in League play (2<sup>nd</sup> in the GSL) with just two games left in the regular season.

**SOCCER** – Mead lost a heartbreaker Monday against Gonzaga Prep at Union. Both teams played evenly for nearly 80 minutes, but a foul called in stoppage time led to a Bullpup penalty kick. Prep converted and won, 1-0. Wednesday at Ridgeline, the Panthers bounced back and defeated Ridgeline in overtime, 2-1. Reese Walker had a goal and assisted on Teryn Gardner's game winner in the extra period. With 3 games left, Mead is 4-2 in League play and tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> in the overall GSL standings (tied for 1<sup>st</sup> in 3A)

**BOYS & GIRLS CROSS COUNTRY** – The Girls remained undefeated in League races with wins Wednesday at Liberty Lake Regional Park. Mead defeated Mt. Spokane, 25-31 and Ridgeline, 21-34. The Boys have one League loss after splitting with Ridgeline and Mt. Spokane. Defeating the Falcons, 22-50 and losing to the Wildcats 22-35. Both Teams were in Richland Saturday for the Max Jensen Invitational and both placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in close team races. Charlotte Cullen was 2<sup>nd</sup> overall and the Girls were 2<sup>nd</sup> behind Wenatchee, 87-88. In the Boys race, Noah Holden finished 3<sup>rd</sup> and Mead was 2<sup>nd</sup>, behind West Valley of Yakima, 48-62.

**VOLLEYBALL** – The Girls picked up two League wins last week. Tuesday, they defeated a tough University team, 21-25, 25-14, 25-23, 25-19. Thursday at Ferris, the Panthers defeated the Ferris Saxons, 23-25, 25-11, 25-15, 25-19. Danikah Johnson totaled 32 kills in Mead's two wins. The Panthers are 3-0 in League play, tied for 1<sup>st</sup> place with two other teams.
